Learn to Sweep: Club has Access to 6-8 boats, need 9-18 individuals for Learn to Sweep, for success

2013: Advertised Lowell Sun, Learn to Row Day.. not well attended

Feedback has been: Cost too high to allow individual to try the sweep program

Discussion: Trial, low price \$99 for 4 weeks, introductory- twice a week, something less than last year

Currently \$300 for 6 weeks, row twice a week

Sessions were held Mon and Wed Evenings 5:30 pm

Discussion about moving time, too early for individuals coming after work

Need to advertise: Broaden advertising, think about populations we should target **Discussion**: UML community, MRRA already listed on UML web site, how do we gain interest

Encourage team building with companies?, brochures at spartan races, 5K's, local Gyms?

Advertise at LHS regattas in the spring, parents may be interested

Propose: Attend Lowell HS Junior Regattas in Spring:

MRRA to have informational Booth

Sculling: Only one Learn to Sculler joined MRRA in 2013

Need to find a way to build membership, retain individuals

Agree, individuals try rowing, more difficult and physically challenging than expected Decide not for them, don't want to continue, may not feel confident enough to continue without "buddy system." Chur Masors has tried to encourage, how can club help?

Mentoring: Need to invite new members to row in boats with current members, mixed Make feel more a part of the club, use of 4X, more experienced rowers, possibly rowing board in boat house, email, to encourage.

Group rows in the past on Saturday, Full moon rows, Social Committee to address.

Regattas:

Festival Regatta on a Sunday In June - **30th Anniversary** MRRA has run successfully, earned about \$5K for one day event

**Invited by US Rowing to Host Masters Regional Regatta

Looking for New Venue, bridge construction, Lake Quinsigamond
Merrimack River: Great Venue for water and spectators
US rowing provides registration, referees, schedules, medals
MRRA to provide venue, volunteers for start, finish, launches, course, facilities
Need Core group of Volunteers to work on budget, feasibility
US Rowing would pay \$ TBA to MRRA for event
Additional revenues to club for parking, vender tents, concessions

Requirement:

US Rowing asking for 3 year commitment for the Regatta Event US Rowing needs late June, early July date, need to choose a date, perhaps last weekend in June, Father's Day weekend?

Expects: about 300 entries

Suggest: US Rowing Event on Saturday and Festival Regatta on Sunday-Same

Weekend

(prevent duplication of work, course, volunteer commitment, launches)

Proposing:

Core committee: Need 4-6 Volunteers

Develop Budget

Lowell Regatta Rowing Association owns the Race Course

Propose: Rent and use for Masters Regatta and Festival Regatta

Members: Concern about too close to July 4 th weekend- members being away Discussion about Earlier weekend in June, possibly Father's Day weekend, African American Festival June 21, field not available for parking

UML and LHS - Request renting sculling equipment:

Request to rent MRRA sculling equipment for "better rowers"

Varsity rowers 4-8 individuals, limited number, coaches would like opportunity to use 1X Rent equipment before MRRA season starting

Dave Cormier and Coach Alex from Lowell HS making request

Karen Scammell: Asking what members think?: Boathouse at capacity, no room if purchased own equipment. MRRA rents 8's.

Member discussion:

Members at meeting agree: Should use standard, boat captain testing: Major concern safety and avoiding equipment damage

*Students would be rowing afternoons only- some MRRA members rowing off peak concern about having equipment available

*Students would always be supervised (members wanting to know specifics)

Sculling is not sweep rowing, different concerns about safety, navigating the river, equipment damage, deductibles will be \$1000, if damage missing vital equipment when out for repair- added work for Boat Captain

Deductible is \$1000, student would be responsible for whole amount-(MRRA shares cost with members)

General discussion was to limit equipment borrowed to: Fisa, Peinerts, possible old Vespoli 2x

Members in general: Wanting to try to work something out for UML and LHS students Need more information from David and Alex
