It was suggested by Andy if the jet skiers proceeded below the bridge creating no wakes that would be acceptable. It would need to be monitored.

The dangers of a high flow rate was discussed. Should there be a rate that makes rowing unacceptable? We have put out warnings and members have rowed with a high flow rate at their own risk. Generally we have provided recommendations not restrictions. KC and Kate were going to check out other clubs with similar flow rates and their policy for rowing. Dock cleaning was reviewed. The new power hose does work but needs to be fixed. We all agreed that the docks have been cleaner this season.

We need to add docks for the TRR. Kate will have her staff work on preparing the land docks. Some Sat. In Sept. the docks will be added.We will need volunteers from the Club to help out. UML will look into a ramp for the dock.
