David Morley has been arranging to borrow Launches: Need (6-8) Needs will be addressed, more drivers, starting platform driver, Karen has called some Alumni to drive. Contact Alex Gavriel

Jay Feenan: Saturday US Rowing Masters all 1 K races, Sunday Festival Regatta 1K and 2 K races, plan 2 starts, maintain one finish line, will need to have floating start for some races on Sunday.

Starting platforms are at the 2K

Problem is platforms are held by 1/4 inch cable across the river, cannot move, \$1000 for the cable, doesn't make sense to purchase and install second.

US Rowing Regatta requires starting platforms and not floating start. Jay to look at and ask LHS to use Jon boats and other metal boats for start platforms at 1K. These cam be anchored.

Festival Regatta: More referees to reduce the driving up and down course which should reduce wakes
