MRRA SCHOLARSHIP 2019**

The Merrimac River Rowing Association is offering **two (2) \$500.00 scholarships** to class of 2019 graduating high school seniors who have supported and/or participated in rowing programs at the Bellegarde Boathouse. **The scholarship award also includes a fee waived summer student membership and a waived student logbook off-peak program fee with the MRRA for the upcoming season.**

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

- The Scholarship is a \$500.00 non-renewable award, a fee waived summer student membership in the MRRA for the upcoming season **plus** a waived student logbook off-peak program fee; please note that **all other registration requirements, swim test, pass boatcaptians test, must be satisfied.**
- Applicant(s) must have applied and been accepted at a college, university or vocational school at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Receiving the award does not preclude the applicant from applying for and accepting other scholarships, loans, grants or other aid.
- Applicant need not participate in college athletics.
- Recipients will be notified by letter no later than June 01, 2019.
- Application forms can be downloaded from the MRRA web site (www.merrimackrowing.org).

ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who has supported and/or participated in rowing programs at the Bellegarde Boathouse for two years.
- ✓ Must be nominated by a rowing coach or MRRA officer.
- ✓ Must have been accepted at a college, university or vocational school.

REQUIREMENTS:

- I. Completed and signed application form (see page 2).
- II. Typed essay (one page maximum) on the following topic:
“What has rowing brought to your life and how have you in turn been able to give back to the sport?”
- III. List any rowing activities in which you (the applicant) have participated.
(Rowing team, sculling, Textile and/or Festival River Regatta volunteer staff, racing, etc...)
- IV. High School Transcript (copy acceptable).
- V. A copy of acceptance letter to attend an institution of higher learning.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

The selection criteria will be established by the MRRA Scholarship Committee.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All requirements must be **US Post Office postmarked by April 22, 2019** to be considered.
