Lost Masters scullers due to congestion, catering to the small boats worked well Joe L thinks could double the number next year.

Next year may not need to rent docks, to decrease dock rental expense.

Possibly borrow docks from HOCR.

Comments:

80 feet of dock would have been better, traffic cones needed

"Goal to make the area nice for the clubs, small boats to launch".

Registration numbers at the small dock area? That was the only complaint.

Racers had to go to boathouse to obtain registration packets.

Vee Platzer asking if we would consider taking reservations for boat trailers.

May ask for RSVP to trailers at the Small boat area

Report from the Beach: Jason Holden

Beach launch dock was long and narrow (140 feet)

Launched 3 8's one one side, tight, launching continuously.

Trailer Space: Parking: Jay Feenan

Trailer space was stressed, late arrivals. Invest in man power by the end of the boulevard. Need traffic, trailer director on the street.

One complaint from neighbors, parking on the side roads, will need to post on the one way, No Regatta parking, emergency vehicles could not pass on these streets.

Noise complaint, music testing at 5:30 AM, City hall assistant manager called,

No Noise until after 8 AM is the law.

Next year: Maybe encourage politicians to come down, especially pre election Used to give trophies, metal ceremony in the past.

Team Trophy, Wenger Trophy, add to PR.

Discussion about adding more Orange buoys, Linas, intends white bleach bottles

Will ask the membership to vote on club participation in NEMA/Festival and TRR/ US Rowing Regattas:

Plan to add to ballot this December

I Will Volunteer! check box.

Agree need more volunteers for LOC, again regattas are how the club makes money for boat purchases, equipment maintenance and to run rowing programs.

General discussion is that, Not much more work for 2 day vs one day regatta Costs for course, port o john's, tents, pay once use twice.

TRR demographics have changed, used to evenly spread between juniors, open and Masters, now more juniors, fewer colleges.

Two day Regatta would allow events to be more spread out, allow lunch break. Easier flow. Could separate junior races and Masters events

Benefit for trying the TRR and US rowing event next Fall would be to test changing the TRR to a 2 day regatta the following year. If club doesn't accept the Fall US Rowing Masters event, where will it go? Possibly close by and may disrupt TRR?

Carl plans to take \$1000 for a paid internship for research, would approach HS students about 20 hours to work on building a bio for the coaches and clubs.

Develop a detailed Regatta Map where all the signage needs to go, tent locations, parking, etc.

Could also send a survey about where boats launched.

Carl will post job description.
May also look at UML student, business management sports management student to help with research.
