- We are contracting for legal assistance with a lawyer that fully understands leases, lease to own and local Tyngsboro politics.
- We will be contacting other clubs about our move.
- We will extend our lease at Bellegarde Boathouse for six months.
- There was a brief discussion about funding the purchase of the new boathouse. We plan on using private funding sources.
