Plan letter to coaches for next year:

Continued Growth, entries could go to 800 by next year

Need to discuss capping some events

Amanda, mentioned possibly allowing mixed boats with juniors, allow every team one entry....

Next year likely to cut off Registration for MRRA earlier, UML, LHS at least 2 weeks in advance. Will allow for Volunteer assignments to be determined in a timely manner. Plan to purchase scale for light weight weigh ins.

Roland present: To explain events leading to damage to Fluid 1 X Deductible on the Fluid 1X damage: \$1000 cost to repair is \$1710

Mark Romanowsky sent note with his thoughts Discussion about damage payments in general:

If damage over the \$1000 deductible, and going to insurance, member should be responsible for \$500.

Secondary discussion: Clear Negligence vs Accident:

- 1. **Clear Negligence:** hitting a fixed object, dock, stake boats, etc MRRA member should be responsible for \$500
- 2. **Accident**: Hitting a submerged object.....displaying reasonable care Should MRRA member still pay the \$500, or something less ?

Insurance plan requires higher deductible. Review with John Ballentine that MRRA budget includes \$2000 for damage to equipment. Discussion: Private shells could easily pay deductibles as high as \$1000 2-3 incidents per year, budget has covered. Agree boat damage policy: needs work on wording: Cap at \$500 per boat per incident **Gross negligence pays the full cost Jason recommending something between zero and \$500 for accident Decision by board to have Ronald pay \$250, found not gross negligence

Time for Elections:

All Board seats open. Mark Romanowsky trustee term is up Dottie to review with Wilma the ballot procedures

Planning: "Smack Down and Boat Wash" Nov 4th Invite surrounding clubs, pot luck Wash and inventory boats Docks usually pulled the following week
