Comments budget / actual 2016

- Base club expenses are higher than are covered by the original \$125/\$100/year (additional \$18/person)
 - At March Budget meeting, agreed to increase base membership from \$125 to \$150.
 - This will be realized fully in 2017
- Sweep realized Boat Rental fee of \$1900
- Purchase of equipment, still <u>depends</u> on regattas
- Strong cash position

Textile River Regatta 2016

- Revenue \$ 65,770 (includes 9900 parking and 7000 vendors)
- Expense \$(43,393)
- Profit \$ 22,373
- higher expenses of approximately due to timing (500) and LRRA (6000) and other/security (2000)
- ending balance before distribution, 44,700

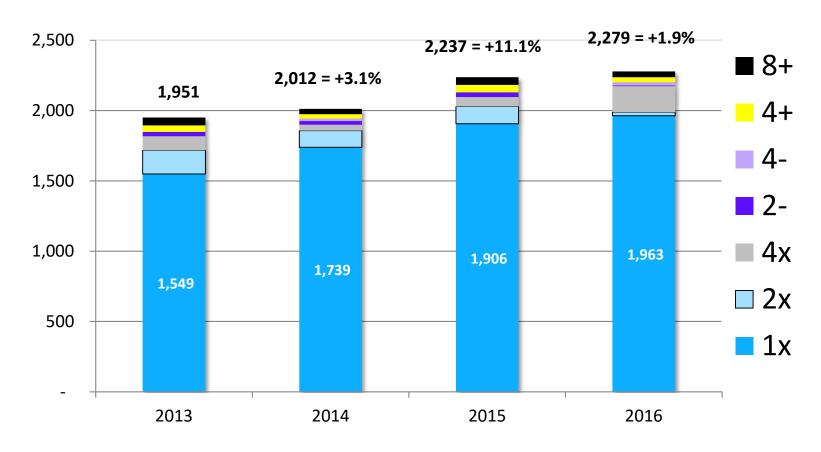

- Carolina Skiff out of commission for a good portion of the late summer due to maintenance issues

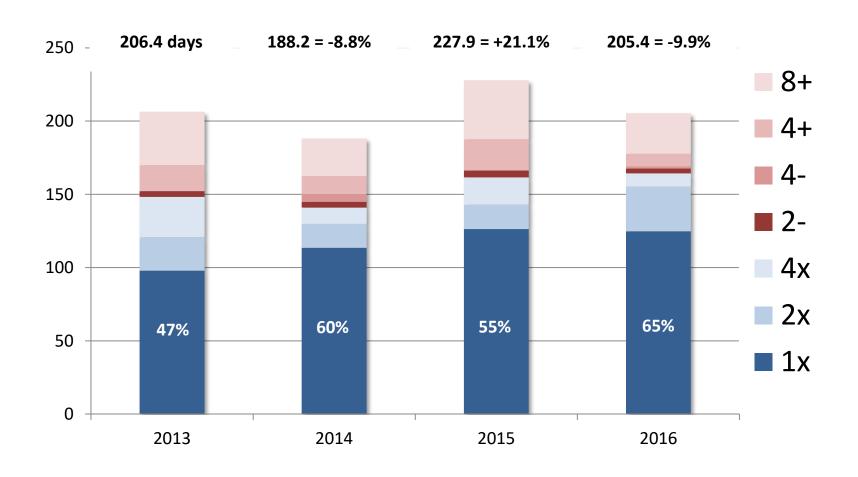
MRRA LOGBOOK STATS 2016

Total Rowing Trips

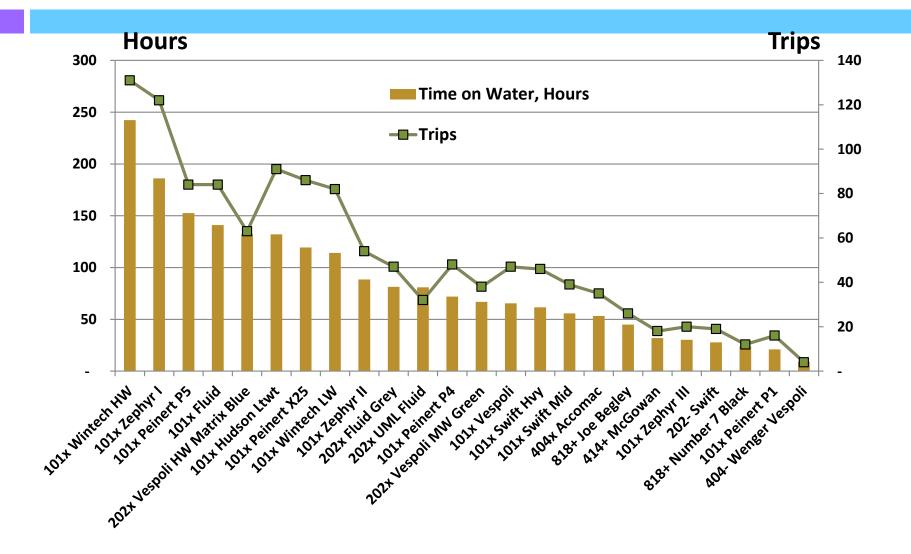


Wenger 4- out for repair July thru season

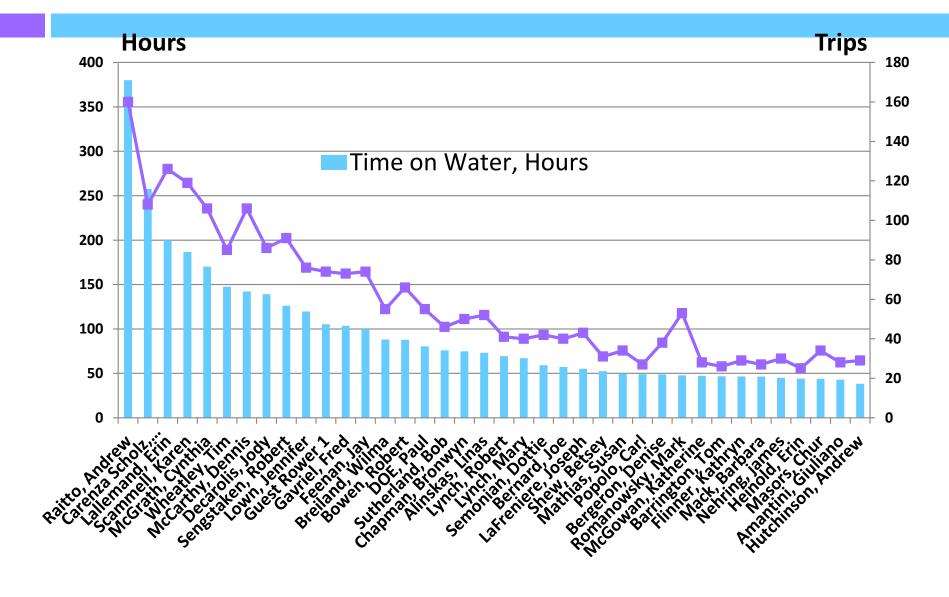
Total Rowing Time

Approval of Base Membership

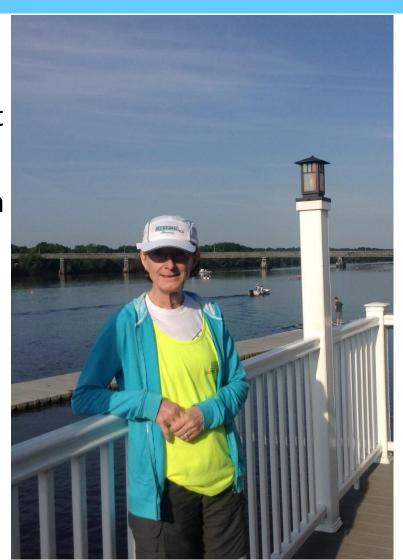
- Keep Base Membership at \$150 for 2017
