Mark Romanowsky reviewing an important safety tip:

 Hydration: Start the night before, limit alcohol consumption 15-20 min of water before row
 Simple Carbs, peach or plum 15-20 min prior
 Cool water will hydrate more quickly
 Add water every 15-20 min for high intensity workouts
 Longer rows, bring water, or electrolytes, one hour into row

**After Row**: Best re-hydration is Milk, carbohydrates and simple protein ETOH not good Careful of caffeine

Typically high Bacteria counts after heavy rains

Joe Lafreniere would like to bring to MRWC attention: He feels individuals stack Logs- intentionally leaving debris along the rivers edge, aware will wash away in heavy rains, safety issue.

Dam system- species are impacted with water drops

Also impacts water quality when not flowing, also debris at pilings of the Roarke Bridge E. Coli- swimming vs boating exposures run off after rain impacts, sewerage outflow Class B Water: Much better than Charles or Ipswich Rivers

Open sweep rigged rented hull last year, made sure available as 4X Need to have qualified members to rig and de-rig Open Sweep- historically has also rented hull for racing, paid by individuals or from their budget (to avoid long absents from boathouse) Proposing \$21K for equipment purchases for 2013 Allocate \$10K to upgrade the current HW 4X to a MW/HW 4X/4-Allocate \$11K to up grade 3 1X's
