\* Update Boathouse User group meeting: UML, LHS and Junior US Rowing regattas: Every weekend in the month of May. MRRA Members need to be off the water early. If rowing later, must ask permission of the Regatta Director. Rowers must hold at the DCR boat ramp and wait for permission to row to the end of the course. Please be, Respectful of the officials. Members will receive e-mail updates regarding the start times of the regattas and they will be placed on the MRRA Calendar.

\*Lightning detector: boathouse has hand held unit available, is locked up, anyone can use

\* Dock extension: TRR purchased docks, they will be added to the current docks to widen the space. They will be marked TRR and configured with the UML dock system (docks should be delivered by mid May).

\*Launch maintenance and ownership: Discussion about pooling resources between MRRA, UML and LHS. Group to maintain Launches, proposal to share equipment. May purchase wake less launch. Little overlap between programs, should work well. MRRA members with concern about the current equipment, concern about maintenance of current equipment. Consensus was to wait and discuss further with more specifics. Members agree common gas location and purchasing makes sense.

\* Boat rental = sharing agreement proposal: Last year MRRA paid UML \$1762 to rent boats. Working on agreement to not pay to rent boats from UML in exchange for experienced UML rowers under the direction of coaches would be allowed restricted use to MRRA Sculling equipment. 1X, 2X, no 4X, No A Boats, no reserving boats, no prime time rowing. UML would be responsible for any damage to equipment. Students would then be encouraged to join the MRRA for \$65 after their season ends.

ERGS: Available MRRA always has access to at least 3 if being used by UML.

\*US Rowing and Festival Regatta weekend planning -Barbara Sherman has agreed to coordinate Volunteers: Members should contact Barbara if they have requests for specific jobs.
