MINUTES

State of Row

The current state of rowing from the Bellegarde goes as follows:

- We have permission to use the boat bay portion of the house until 14-May when construction begins. Uncertain thereafter.
- The new docks are partially in; not enough for eights, but enough for 1x and 2x launching.
- There are porta-potties in the upstream fenced in area for your convenience. The fenced area has a padlock combo lock -- the solution to this lock is "DON1".
- BOAT WASH AND FIRST ROW THIS SATURDAY 26-APR, 8a to 12p.
- We have additional TRR/FR materials that need to be removed from the boathouse. Two membership requests:
 - If you have significant available storage space that you could share with MRRA temporarily, please let us know.
 - If you are currently storing stuff for MRRA, let us know that too.

FAQ

At this point you might have questions, for which there are no simple answers. In the spirit of making a good guess, here goes:

Can racked boats stay in the house? Maybe. At best, they will probably need to come out while the boat bay roof is shingled. At worst, we may be car-topping for a while. But if the roof work is the only impediment to racking, that

shouldn't be for very long.

Will rowing hours be restricted? Don't know. Joe will work with UML to make sure that we are coordinated with them so that construction trucks aren't blocking the bay doors when you return from an early row. Could this mean a formal system of regulated rowing hours? Don't know.

How do we get into the boathouse today? The short answer is that you don't, but starting after the boatwash, there will the time-honored and traditional Key Access Fiasco that you have come to know and love. So stay tight with a keyholder, and you'll know when the boathouse is open.

Festival Regatta

All other students outside of this category are subject to review and/or may be mentored or closely supervised by a parent or quardian. LTR remains at \$100.

The verbal timeline we have been given is that construction will be finished by early September, but regardless of the inconveniences we may incur, the outcome will be good, and club continuity is more important than ever.
